Subject: Declaration with reference to the following Directives No.:

- 2002/95/EC (Directive "RoHS" - Reduction of Hazardous Substances);
- 2002/96/EC (Directive "WEEE" - Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment).

Dear Customer,

as well known these two European directives refer to the ban/restriction in the use and waste of the following substances:

- Lead;
- Mercury;
- Cadmium;
- Hexavalent Chromium;
- Flame retardants (polybrominated biphenyls-PBB or polybrominated diphenyl ethers-PBDE), in the electrical and electronic equipment from July, 1st 2006.

With reference to these Directives, and especially to the Annex IA and 1B to Directive No. 2002/96/EC ("WEEE"), WAIRCOM MBS SpA declares that **all the standard products shown in the General Catalogue, by themselves are outside the scope of the above mentioned directives and therefore not required to be compliant.**


